The festival is now recognized as New York's most prestigious gathering of pioneering choreography, encouraging experimentation, creativity, and originality. In its 20-year history, WHITE WAVE Dance has proudly presented over 2,800 choreographers/dance companies and over 18,500 performers to a total of more than 82,500 audience members.
